Mermerus Vineyard was established in 1996, and occupies part of the eastern slope of Murradoc Hill on the Bellarine Peninsula. Production is centred in their onsite winery and grapes are sourced mainly from the estate, with a small amount of fruit from local vineyards being used for some years. Indigenous (wild) yeast fermentation plays a major part in the production of their wines.
